
The **Newcomers & Neighbors News** is published for members of the BNNC. Annual membership is \$20. First time members: discounted rate of \$10.

Book Club 1 met 29 May at Bell Trace and discussed the book *Grandma Gatewood's Walk: The Inspiring Story of the Woman Who Saved the Appalachian Trail* by Ben Montgomery, led by Phyllis Sindlinger. This is the story of a 67-year old grandmother who hiked the Appalachian Trail alone in 1955, from Georgia to Maine, and was the first woman to hike the entire 2,200 mile trail. She grew up on a farm in SE Ohio and raised 11 children, after dealing with an abusive husband.



On Wednesday, 31 July, we met again at Bell Trace to discuss the book "Bruno, Chief of Police" by Martin Walker, led by Phyllis Sindlinger. The story takes place in the French province of Perigod, east of Bordeaux, in the small town of St. Denis, with Bruno administering peace and order. The author presents the people, the French customs, and life in this quiet French town and the challenges Bruno faces. After dealing with EU market inspectors he deals with the brutal murder a French soldier, retired with honor, who turns out to have served the Vichy government in WWII to exterminate French resisters. The story ends with justice served. The character of Bruno was also an avid cook. Phyllis brough his cook book to the meeting, and made some of his cookies to share. Cathy also had cookies for us! Chocolate Chip in recognition of Chocolate Chip Cookie Day on August 4th. The cookies were a great way to end the meeting.



We meet again on August 28th to discuss "West with the Night" by Beryl Markham, the story of the first woman to fly across the Atlantic in 1936, landing in a bog in Nova Scotia.
