



### **Book Club 1**

**Book Club 1** met Wednesday, 26 March, to discuss "A Woman of No Importance", by Sonia Purnell, the story of Virginia Hall, a Baltimore socialite, State Dept. employee late 30's, became an American female spy working for the British SOE to 1942, deep in France in World War II, running spy networks, calling air drops of weapons and explosives, leading the French resistance, killing Germans, surviving the Gestapo, German Abwher, and French Milice. The SOE called her back to London. She then worked for the US OSS in France through the end of the war leading the Resistance up to and after D-Day.. The book is a story of spycraft, resistance, and personal triumph. Discussion was led by Meg Bieloski.

March, a military chaplain for the Union Army faces overwhelming challenges to his marriage and the devastating consequences of the war as it plays out in Virginia between Union and Confederate forces.
