

Book Club 1 met Wednesday, 27 Nov, to discuss "River of Doubt: Theodore Roosevelt's Darkest Journey" by Candice Millard. Discussion led by Meg Bieloski

The River of Doubt is a book that tells the true story of Theodore Roosevelt's exploration of one of the most dangerous rivers on earth. The river is a black, uncharted tributary of the Amazon that snakes through one of the most treacherous jungles in the world. Roosevelt's fall 1913 speaking tour of South America following his presidential defeat in 1912 included a tour down several known Brazilian rivers to the Amazon. Receiving word of an unexplored 800 mile river deep in the Amazon jungle, Roosevelt, along with a famous Brazilian Amazon explorer, organized with many difficulties a trip down the River of Doubt. The challenges were daunting: dangerous rapids, snakes, piranhas, disease, insects, hostile natives, starvation. With malaria and an infected leg Roosevelt almost died. Two members of the team did die, one vanished into the jungle. After two months traveling down a black uncharted river, they reached an outpost and help. Roosevelt recovered and made a triumphant return to New York City.
