She is the site manager of the Historic Site, and will talk about the artist, his wife, his studio, and the grounds and events presented there throughout the year.

A voiceover tells the story of Selma Neubacher Steele who preserved the house and grounds as a memorial site after her husbands passing. The exhibit is located in the Media Gallery on the
